Fresh Woodland Greens Container

Bring yourself back to a quiet and peaceful place after the New Year with an artful arrangement of the season's loveliest textures and tones. Choose shade-loving beauties in the fern family and experiment with textural variety. Tuck in the star of every woodland garden – Hellebores – and get ready to enjoy a peaceful respite in your garden.



Tips:

- Choose a variety of shade and water loving plant varieties for this arrangement. Imagine walking through the redwoods, and try to recreate the plants naturally found in a woodland setting.
- When combining ferns, consider color and textural variety.
- Hellebores is called the “Winter Rose” because it blooms in the coldest of temperatures. Find them blooming in shades of purple, pink, burgundy, white, and yellow. Some varieties have lovely mottled foliage.
